

# STUDENT DRIVER VIOLATIONS AND CONSEQUENCES

1. Possession of weapons, alcohol, or controlled dangerous substances.
  - a. 1st offense – Loss of the privilege to park, suspension from school and student will be arrested.
2. Reckless or negligent driving (including reports from the HHS community)
  - a. 1st offense – 3 day suspension of parking privileges
  - b. 2nd offense – 10 day suspension of parking privileges
  - c. 3rd offense – Loss of privilege to park at HHS
3. Not wearing a seatbelt (including driver and any passengers)
  - a. 1st offense – 3 day suspension of parking privileges
  - b. 2nd offense – 5 or more day suspension of parking privileges
  - c. 3rd offense – Loss of privilege to park at HHS
4. Class cutting
  - a. 1st offense – Lunch detentions
  - b. 2nd offense – 3 day suspension of parking privileges
  - c. 3rd offense – 5 day suspension of parking privileges
  - d. 4th offense – 10 day suspension of parking privileges
  - e. 5th offense – Loss of the privilege to park at HHS
5. Student drivers exceeding more than 8 days of unexcused absences may have their parking privileges suspended.
6. Excessive tardies to school will result in the suspension of parking privileges in accordance with the current HHS school tardy policy.
  - a. 4th tardy – 1 day suspension of parking privileges
  - b. 5th tardy – 3 day suspension of parking privileges
  - c. 6th tardy – 5 day suspension of parking privileges
  - d. 7th tardy – 10 day suspension of parking privileges
  - e. 8th tardy – 30 day suspension of parking privileges
7. Illegally transporting a student off campus or leaving school grounds without permission may result in additional disciplinary action.
  - a. 1st offense – 3 day suspension of parking privileges
  - b. 2nd offense – 5 day suspension of parking privileges
  - c. 3rd offense – 10 day suspension of parking privileges
  - d. 4th offense – 30 day suspension of parking privileges.
8. Other violations not included above will be dealt with on an individual basis.

PLEASE NOTE: Students with early release from school are not permitted to return to school property unless they are participating in a school sanctioned event. In this case, students are not permitted back on school property until 2:30 pm. Additionally, students with early release are to leave campus immediately after their last class. They are not to visit with others or to eat lunch at school. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR REVOKED PARKING PRIVILEGES.
