

**Student Driver  
Violations and Consequences**

1. Possession of weapons, alcohol, or controlled dangerous substances.  
**1<sup>st</sup> Offense**—Loss of the privilege to park, suspension from school, and the student will be arrested.
  
2. Reckless or negligent driving (including reports from the HHS Community).  
**1<sup>st</sup> Offense**—3 day suspension of parking privileges  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**—10 day suspension of parking privileges  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**—Loss of the privilege to park at HHS
  
3. Not wearing a seatbelt (including driver and any passenger(s)).  
**1<sup>st</sup> Offense**—3 day suspension of parking privileges  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**—10 day suspension of parking privileges  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**—Loss of the privilege to park at HHS
  
4. Class Cutting  
**1<sup>st</sup> Offense**—Lunch detentions.  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**—3 day suspension of parking privileges  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**—5 day suspension of parking privileges  
**4<sup>th</sup> Offense**—10 day suspension of parking privileges  
**5<sup>th</sup> Offense**—Parking privileges will be revoked
  
5. Student drivers who exceed 8 days of unexcused absences will have their parking privileges suspended.  
**8 unexcused absences**—5 day suspension of parking privileges  
**12 unexcused absences**—10 day suspension of parking privileges  
**16 unexcused absences**—30 day suspension of driving privileges
  
6. Excessive tardies to school will result in the suspension of parking privileges in accordance with the current HHS school tardy policy.  
**4<sup>th</sup> tardy**—1 day suspension of parking privileges  
**5<sup>th</sup> tardy**—3 day suspension of parking privileges  
**6<sup>th</sup> tardy**—5 day suspension of parking privileges  
**7<sup>th</sup> tardy**—10 day suspension of parking privileges  
**8<sup>th</sup> tardy**—30 day suspension of parking privileges
  
7. Illegally transporting a student off campus or leaving school grounds without permission.  
**1<sup>st</sup> Offense**—3 day suspension of parking privileges  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**—5 day suspension of parking privileges  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**—10 day suspension of parking privileges  
**4<sup>th</sup> Offense**—30 day suspension of parking privileges
  
8. Juniors participating in after-school activities will be given priority consideration over other juniors. (You must complete the information on the back of the application form.)
  
9. Juniors must meet the same eligibility requirements as students who participate in extra-curricular activities. A GPA of 70% or better with no more than one failing grade is necessary. The rule will go into effect at the end of each marking period.
  
10. Other violations not included above will be dealt with on an individual basis.

PLEASE NOTE: Students with early release from school are not permitted to return to school property unless they are participating in a school sanctioned event. In this case, students are permitted back on school property until 2:30 PM. Additionally, students with early release are to leave campus immediately after their last class. They are not to visit with others or to eat lunch at school.
